The corpora and tools housed in the SLS collection represent a valuable resource for research in corpus linguistics. Some of these corpora are private and not available to the general public. Please take the agreement and conditions of use described below seriously and respect the agreement.

I understand that by signing this agreement to have access to the SLS corpora and tools I am agreeing to the following:

1. The SLS resources can only be accessed from computers on campus and through the secure server space provided.
2. The corpora can only be used for personal research, and not commercial purposes.
3. I will not copy texts to my hard drive.
4. I can only use excerpts of 40 words of running text.
5. Corpora and excerpts must be properly cited.
6. If I believe that I have damaged a file, I will report it immediately.
7. The Corpus lab (HEAV 201) can **only** be used for corpus research projects. See Shelley Staples to schedule time in the corpus room.
